
Deep Dish Pizza Day!

The first is Ike Sewell. He is the founder of Uno Pizzeria. The second is Rudy Malnati. He is the founder of Lou Malnati's.







Either way, if you ask the people of Chicago where to get a good deep dish pizza, they'll point you to one of these two pizzerias! But what makes a deep dish pizza?
